
Key Local Plan Policies

Plan 1 **Frenchay Conservation Area**

Designated as a Conservation Area in 1975. Part to the north/west of the River Frome was designated by the former Northavon District Council 30th July 1975. The remainder to the southleast of the river designated 13th August 1975 by the former Kingswood District

Preservation & Enhancement Strategy

To encourage appropriate management, protection and enhancement of the following features / elements and their settings

Conservation Area Boundary

Maintain existing endosure to roads and encourage reinstatement of sections of stone walls that have been removed.

Protect views to skyline/valley and quarry top. Ensure adjoining development does not encroach/ detract from views.

Protect setting of adjacent open space/woodlands. Ensure boundary treatment or erection of structures does not encroach or detract from its natural character or harm views.

Protect setting of Frenchay Park, listed buildings and parkland.

Secure enhancements and improvements where necessary to boundary treatment/structures and planting to soften the impact of development.

Main areas of open space, commons, verges and gardens, which contribute to landscape character.(only larger spaces shown - other areas also contribute to character)
