- 7. New applications to vote by post or by postal proxy, and amendments or cancellations to existing postal or proxy arrangements, must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 17 April 2024**.
- 8. New applications to vote by proxy must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024**.
- 9. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024**.

- 10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy on the grounds of a medical emergency or for work/service reasons must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Thursday 2 May 2024. The medical emergency must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware after 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024 that they cannot go to the polling station in person.
