GENERAL INFORMATION

- All bookings must be made through a Funeral Director.
- Decaying floral tributes on graves will be removed by cemetery staff (unless a specific request has been made to the Cemetery Office for the tributes to be removed by the family).
- All floral and memorial tributes must be contained within the internal flower container, or placed on the masonry only. Any other items will be removed by cemetery staff.
- The cemetery staff will ensure that the level of the graves does not fall below the level of the surrounding area during the six months following interment.
- Burial graves should be left at least 9 months after interment before masonry can be fitted by a registered Stone Mason. Your stone mason will contact the Cemetery Office to obtain a permit.
- Turfing of graves in Lawn areas will take place either in the following spring or autumn.
- Dogs are not allowed in any of the cemeteries with the exception of assistance or guide dogs.

KINGSWOOD REMEMBRANCE PARK BS15 9SE

Kingswood Remembrance Park is situated off Grimsbury Road, Kingswood, established in 2010.

Kingswood Remembrance Park has a Traditional section, Lawn section, Muslim section, an Infants section and Cremated Remains section, with beautiful and inspiring views over South Gloucestershire. There are ample parking spaces, and 4 lay-bys where water taps and bins are available.

MAYSHILL CEMETERY BS36 2NU

Mayhill Cemetery is located just off the Badminton Road between Coalpit Heath & Nibley near Yate, established in 1973.

Mayhill has a Traditional section, Lawn section, an Infants section and a Cremated Remains section.

Graves can be pre purchased at this cemetery.

FILTON & MANGOTSFIELD CEMETERIES

There are no new burial plots available at Mangotsfield or Filton cemeteries.

Mangotsfield cemetery has columbarium niches for cremated remains interments.

FILTON BS16 1QD

Filton Cemetery is a traditional cemetery established in 1947. The cemetery is located off Coldharbour Road in Filton.

MANGOTSFIELD BS16 6UY

Mangotsfield Cemetery is located off Westerleigh Road in Downend, and is the oldest South Gloucestershire Council Cemetery, established in 1850.

CHAPEL

We have a small chapel seating approximately 50 people at Mangotsfield Cemetery, which may be used for services prior to interment at any of our South Gloucestershire Council cemeteries, or for any other ceremony bookings.
