
PROPOSED RELEVANT AREA FOR ADMISSIONS 2025/26 and 2026/27

The Law requires all authorities to set out the Relevant Area for school admissions. The Relevant Area describes the geographical area within which consultations on individual school admissions takes place.

This is important in ensuring that parents and other interested parties can read the proposed admission arrangements for schools and academies that will apply in future years.

It is proposed that the Relevant Area for school admissions in South Gloucestershire (including consultation and admission arrangements) in 2025/26 and 2026/27 should continue to be the whole administrative area of South Gloucestershire Council as outlined in the map below.



Definition of Relevant Area

The area for a school (determined by its local authority and then reviewed every two years) within which the admission authority for that school must consult all other prescribed schools on its admission arrangements.
