Benefits Advice

Housing Benefit

Contact the Housing Benefit Department at South Gloucestershire Council to make an application or discuss a claim. <u>01454 86 8002</u>. Alternatively you may attend your local Council One Stop Shop office for assistance.

Council Tax

You may be eligible for Council Tax Reduction. You may attend your local Council One Stop Shop for assistance submitting your Council Reduction Form.



Discretionary Housing Payment (DHP)

You may be eligible for a DHP if you are in receipt of Housing Benefit or the housing element of Universal Credit (UC). You may be able to get a DHP to help with: a spare room that Housing Benefit will not cover; benefit caps reducing your Housing

Benefit or UC; your benefit being reduced because there is a non-dependent in the household; a deposit or rent in advance for moving to a new home; removal costs; a shortfall in the amount of Housing Benefit you receive and the cost of your rent.

Other Useful Information

Warm and Well

Warm and Well's trained energy advisers give free energy efficiency advice that will help you stay warmer and healthier in your home. This ranges from simple changes you can make, to helping you access grants for insulation or providing information about renewable technologies. They can help you to reduce your energy bills, switch your energy tariff or supplier, and help you find local installers and tradespeople. They may be able to offer you a free home energy visit.

Sure Start Maternity Grant

This is a one-off payment of £500 to help towards the costs of having a child. You usually qualify for the grant if both of the following apply:

- you're expecting your first child, or you're expecting a multiple birth (such as twins) and have children already; and
- you or your partner already get certain benefits.



You must claim the grant within 11 weeks of the baby's due date or within 6 months after the baby's birth. You do not have to pay the grant back and it will not affect your other benefits or tax credits. For more information please visit: https://www.gov.uk/sure-start-maternity-grant
