A general outline of the special responsibilities you perform

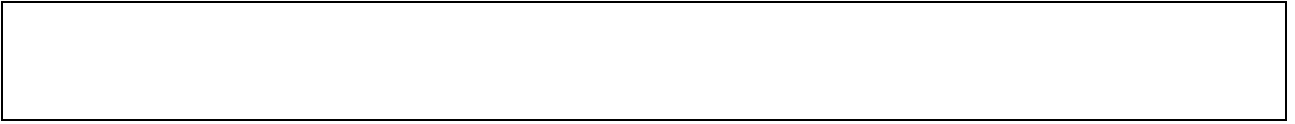
Supporting and deputising for the Chair of Council when he was unavailable, e.g. double-booked, ill or on holiday.
