Guidance notes to persons submitting notice:

- This form may be used by the occupier of a track premises or a person responsible for the administration of events at a track premises, to give notice of an occasional use to South Gloucestershire Council so as to allow licensed betting operators to accept bets on the premises.
- Occasional use notices only have effect for 8 days or fewer per calendar year for any track premises. If it is intended to offer betting facilities more frequently than this, a premises licence must be obtained under Part 8 of the Gambling Act 2005.
- There is currently no fee or charge with the submitting of an occasional use notice.
- Please complete this notice, print, sign and copy it, together with any supporting documents to Avon and Somerset Constabulary, at the same time as the notice is submitted to South Gloucestershire Council at the address stated at the top of the notice form.
