A general outline of the special responsibilities you perform

As a Cabinet Member I attend all the related Cabinet meetings and Informal Cabinet meetings providing strategic leadership and executive powers for the running of the Council. I remain answerable for my portfolio responsibilities and for Cabinet decisions with the regular engagement this brings with the public, Cabinet members and Council staff.

I am the Lead Member for Adults which requires me to be up to date with all the developments relating to this area of the Council activity and answerable for the actions of the department.

I am the Lead Member for Public Health which requires me to be familiar with all strategic development and implementation issues that arise in this area. This includes being a member of the Council's Clinical Assurance Group.

I manage the Council's relationship with the NHS and strategic health partners. As such I am involved with various external meetings with partner organisations and lobby groups such as ADASS and the Local Government Association.

I am responsible for Chairing the Health and Wellbeing Board (HWB) which includes the agenda, planning meetings and themed workshop meetings. As Chairman I work with the board members and attend the Senior Officer Group that helps to shape the agenda for the board.

I lead the HWB representation in the BNSSG 3 HWB Group which includes North Somerset HWB and Bristol HWBs.

I am Chairman of the South West HWB Network which represents the 15 HWBs in the region.

I am Chairman of the South West Adults Lead Member Network group which is made up of 18 Local Authorities and is jointly sponsored by South West Councils and the Local

Govt Association. I present an annual report of our activity to the South West Councils Board.

I am Chairman of the Learning Difficulties Partnership Board and am involved with moving the agenda forward with its board members in the same way as detailed for the HWB above.

I sit on the Council's Senior Officer Employment Panel.

I am an active member of the Council's Food Cell and Member-led Covid Response Group. I am an active member of the Local Plan Policy Advisory Group (PAG).

I am responsible for the Council's HomeChoice housing service and also have oversight of the Council's affordable housing delivery. There are regular meetings required to remain up to date on this agenda including meetings with the leaders of Bromford Housing Group.

I am the Council's representative on the Cotswolds Conservation Board and attend at least 6 related meetings a year.

The main achievement has been the ability to take all these areas forward through the Covid emergency

I have been able to link people together and I am especially proud for my role in making them comfortable and engaged with the programme through my chairmanship of many online meetings.
