


Relevant area for admissions 2027/2028 and 2028/2029

The Law requires all authorities to set out the Relevant Area for school admissions. The Relevant Area describes the geographical area within which consultations on individual school admissions take place.

This is important in ensuring that parents and other interested parties can read the admission arrangements for schools and academies that will apply in future years.

The Relevant Area for school admissions in South Gloucestershire (including consultation and admission arrangements) in 2027/28 and 2028/29 will continue to be the whole administrative area of South Gloucestershire Council as outlined in the map below.



Definition of Relevant Area

The area for a school (determined by its local authority and then reviewed every two years) within which the admission authority for that school must consult all other prescribed schools on its admission arrangements.
