Your Privacy Information.

Your Information

This Privacy Information relates to the personal information we will collect when you ask for a Covid-19 Surge Testing kit to be delivered to your home. We will use this data to send the kit to your address:

- Full name
- Postal address
- Number of people in your household aged 16+

We have made sure we will use your information according to the UK Data Protection laws by establishing the lawful condition of Article 6(1)(a) – consent.

Once your kit is returned it will be processed in accordance with the national test and trace system.

How we'll use your information

We'll use your information to provide the above service you have requested whilst complying with the established lawful conditions.

Who we can share your information with

In order to provide the service you required we will share your information with:

- only the relevant teams within the council
- partners who may work with the council to deliver this service

For example:

- Avon fire and rescue service
- Town and parish councils

We may also share your information with others outside of the Council e.g. regulators and other public organisations for the detection and prevention of crime.

How long we'll keep your information

Once your kit has been successfully delivered the data will be securely destroyed.

This is a time limited project of two weeks. You will not be required to re-apply for further tests

We may retain anonymised information about the service we provided to help us improve our services in the future.

Transferring your information overseas

Your information is not transferred and stored in countries outside the UK for the provision of this service.

Your rights

You have a number of rights relating to your information e.g. to see what we hold, to ask us to share it with another party, ask us to update incorrect or incomplete details, to object to or restrict processing of it or to make a complaint about how we are handling it. If you have given us your permission to use your information you also have the right to withdraw that permission at any time in the future.
