Wash your hands before and after taking or collecting your child from school.



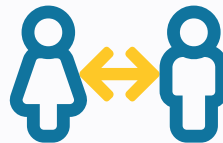
Leave promptly after drop off/pick up.

indoor venues and on public transport.

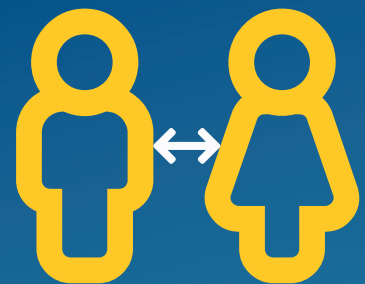
***Exemptions include:**
