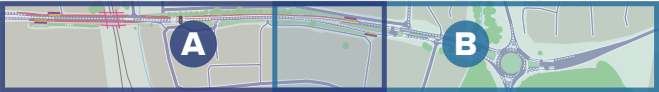
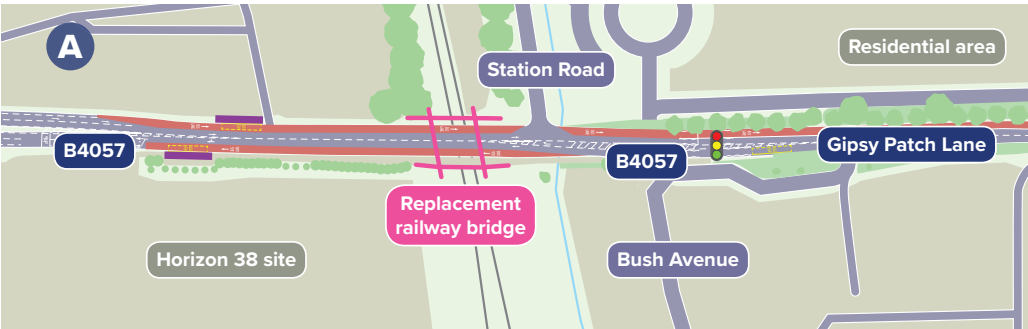
metrobus extension works

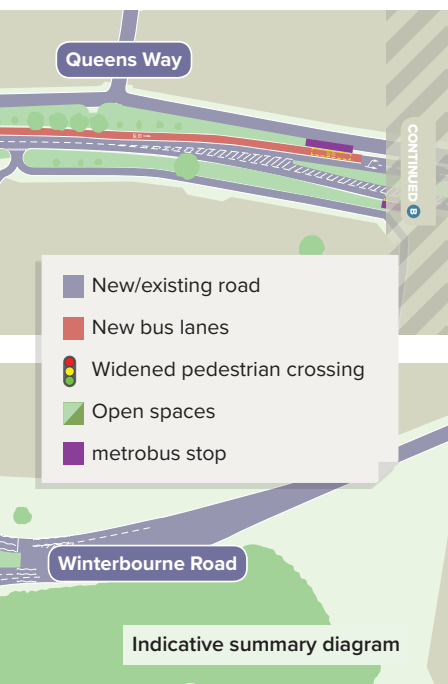
The Cribbs Patchway metrobus extension (CPME) will extend the existing metrobus network in the West of England. It will link Bristol Parkway Station with The Mall via Hatchet Road, Gipsy Patch Lane and through the new Horizon 38 site and Cribbs Patchway New Neighbourhood on the former Filton Airfield.

Works will include:

- Demolition of existing narrow railway bridge over Gipsy Patch Lane and replacement with a wider bridge to remove the current bottleneck
- Widening of Gipsy Patch Lane to create bus lanes
- New and improved shared use paths for cyclists and pedestrians
- Bus stop upgrades and new stops
- A new bus only link road connecting the Cribbs Patchway New Neighbourhood with the San Andreas roundabout near The Mall. The roundabout will also be signalised.

Roadworks for new bus lanes and metrobus stops continue with ongoing traffic management



EARLY 2022

Construction complete and metrobus services operating on the CPME route
